

W. Bruce Cameron began his career writing a family newspaper humor column, eventually become an internationally syndicated columnist. His column, 8 Simple Rules for Dating My Teenage Daughter, became a New York Times bestselling book and a People's Choice Award-winning series on ABC. It currently runs in syndication in 33 countries worldwide.

However, he is perhaps best known as the Benchley Award-winning, #1 USA TODAY and #1 New York Times bestselling author of the A Dog's Purpose series of books. Along with his wife Cathryn Michon, W. Bruce Cameron is also a screenwriter for the film A Dog's Purpose, which has gone on to become the most successful international live action dog movie of all time. W. Bruce and Cathryn also wrote the screenplay for A Dog's Way Home, which premiered in January of 2019. He has published 18 books and his work has been translated into over 60 languages.

A Dog's Journey, the sequel to A Dog's Purpose, was published in May 2012, He and his wife Cathryn are the screenwriters of this film, as well, which will be released on May 17th.

His novels for younger readers have won awards and are being taught in classrooms everywhere. They include Ellie's Story, Bailey's Story, and the recently released Toby's Story. He is currently at work on the highly anticipated conclusion to the Dog's Purpose trilogy, A Dog's Promise, which will be published in October of 2019.
